The REAL-Oregon Board of Directors is excited to announce that Greg Addington will be the first Executive Director for this exciting new project. He will assume these duties in April and start the process of planning for Class 1 which is slated to begin later this year.

Prior to coming to REAL-Oregon Greg worked for the Klamath Water Users Association (KWUA) for 10 years as its executive director and has worked for the past two years as a private consultant for KWUA and other clients. Previous to his work in the Klamath, Greg worked for the Oregon Farm Bureau (OFB) for over nine years, first as a regional coordinator, then as associate director of governmental affairs. Greg was an outstanding member of the OFB staff. Prior to Greg's arrival at KWUA, the organization had not had an executive director serve more than about three years because of the high pressure of the position and the complexity and intractability of the issues they face. Importantly, Greg is a graduate of the former Leadership Oregon Institute and is a true believer in the kind of leadership education that REAL Oregon will provide. Last year, he was honored as a Distinguished Alumnus by University of Idaho for his work and dedication to the agriculture community.

Bill Buhrig, Chairman of the REAL-Oregon board of directors said he and the board are looking forward to getting Class 1 started with Greg's involvement. "We look forward to a great relationship with Greg and know that he will bring a dynamic and positive energy to this professional development program."

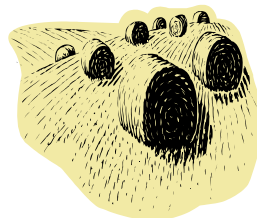
